This Privacy Policy describes the personal and non-personal information we collect when you visit the Sites, how we use that information, and the choices you have about its use.

Information We Collect

By entering your phone number and selecting to opt in, you consent to join a recurring SMS/MMS text messaging program that will provide alerts, updates, and other important information. Personal Information

Personal information is any information that allows us to identify you individually, such as your name, phone number, mailing address, or email address. To use certain features of our Sites—such as contacting us or signing up to receive information—you may be required to provide personal information. We do not collect this personal information unless you voluntarily provide it to us.

Log Data

When you visit our Sites, we may collect information your browser sends, such as your Internet Protocol (IP) address, browser type, browser version, the pages you visit on our Sites, the time and date of your visit, the time spent on those pages, and other statistics. This information may also include your Internet service provider and the website that referred you to our Sites. We use this information for analytics, site performance, and to improve user experience.

Non-Personal Information

We may collect non-personal information about our users to enhance the effectiveness of our Sites, such as aggregated traffic patterns, device information, and site usage data. This information does not identify you personally.

Cookies and Tracking Technologies

We use cookies (small data files stored on your device) and web beacons (also known as pixel tags, clear GIFs, or web bugs) to collect usage information, recognize your device, and improve the functionality of our Sites. Cookies can store information related to your browser, device, and

activity on our Sites. Web beacons help us measure the effectiveness of email campaigns and track aggregated usage.

You can choose to accept or refuse cookies by adjusting your browser settings; however, some features of the Sites may not function as intended without cookies. Third-party vendors providing services to us may also use cookies or web beacons, and their use is subject to their own privacy policies.

Sharing Your Information

We may share or disclose the information we collect:

- 1. When required by law, regulation, legal process, or enforceable governmental request
- 2. To enhance or improve the Sites or your experience with the Sites
- 3. In connection with a merger, acquisition, reorganization, or other asset transfer of our organization
- 4. When we believe disclosure is necessary to protect the safety of our users or the Sites
- 5. With third parties that perform services for us

Social Networking

If you use your login information from a social networking website on our Sites to share our page or content, we may receive information from that social network. Information we receive from them is governed by this Privacy Policy, and information we share with them is governed by their own privacy policy.

We use commercially acceptable means to protect your personal information, but no method of transmission over the Internet or electronic storage is 100% secure. We cannot guarantee absolute security.

Children's Privacy
